## To California Residents

## Effective 4/1/2024

We take your privacy seriously. This Privacy policy for California Residents defines how we collect, use, retain, and disclose personal information about California residents. It also explains certain new rights that California residents have under the California Consumer Privacy Act, as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (together, the "CCPA"). These include the right to access, delete, and correct their data. Visit our *Privacy Policy* for more information.

#### Personal Information We Collect

CSI collects the following categories/specific pieces of personal information protected by the CCPA:

#### • Identifiers:

Identifiers such as a real name, alias, postal address, unique personal identifier (such as a device identifier; cookies, beacons, pixel tags, mobile ad identifiers and similar technology; customer number, unique pseudonym, or user alias; telephone number and other forms of persistent or probabilistic identifiers), online identifier, internet protocol address, email address, account name, Social Security number, driver's license number, passport number, and other similar identifiers

#### • Additional Data Subject to Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.80:

Signature, physical characteristics or description, state identification card number, insurance policy number, education, bank account number, credit card number, debit card number, and other financial information, medical information, and health insurance information

#### Protected Classifications:

Characteristics of protected classifications under California or federal law, such as race, color, national origin, religion, age, sex, gender, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation, marital status, medical condition, ancestry, genetic information, disability, citizenship status, and military and veteran status

### • Commercial Information:

Commercial information, including records of personal property, products or services purchased, obtained, or considered, and other purchasing or consuming histories or tendencies

#### • Biometric Information:

Biometric information includes, but is not limited to, imagery of the iris, retina, fingerprint, face, hand, palm, vein patterns, and voice recordings, from which an identifier template, such as a faceprint, a minutiae template, or a voiceprint, can be extracted, and keystroke patterns or rhythms, gait patterns or rhythms, and sleep, health, or exercise data that contain identifying information.

#### Online Activity:

Internet and other electronic network activity information, including, but not limited to, browsing history, search history, and information regarding your interaction with websites, applications, or advertisements

#### • Geolocation Data:

Include elements such as location information (e.g., city and state, or precise location information if location services are active on your device).





#### • Sensory Information:

Audio, electronic, visual, thermal, olfactory, and similar information

#### • Employment Information:

Professional or employment-related information

#### • Education Information:

Education information that is not publicly available personally identifiable information as defined in the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. Sec. 1232g; 34 C.F.R. Part 99)

#### • Inferences:

Inferences drawn from any of the information identified above to create a profile about you reflecting your preferences, characteristics, psychological trends, predispositions, behavior, attitudes, intelligence, abilities, and aptitudes.

### Purpose of Collection

We may use the categories of personal information listed above for the purposes described in this CCPA Privacy Policy.

CSI collects this information for use in business operations, employment verification and decision-making, payroll, benefits administration, responses to law enforcement requests, in preparation of compulsory tax returns or government agency reports, and otherwise as required or permitted by applicable law, court order, or regulation.

The personal information described in this policy may be disclosed to third parties such as payroll companies, insurance providers, and benefits administrators. CSI may also share this information with clients when placing an employee on assignment. CSI requires the client to execute a non-disclosure agreement before CSI will provide to the client any employee's personal information.

In addition, we may use these categories of personal information for certain business purposes specified in the CCPA, as described in this table.

# Know Your CCPA Rights

The California Consumer Privacy Act, as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (together, the "CCPA") aims to provide California residents with additional privacy rights, including the right to access, delete, limit, and correct their personal data. If you are a California resident, CCPA secures your consumer privacy rights, including the right to:

- **Know** (1) the categories and/or specific pieces of personal information they have collected about you, (2) the categories of sources for that personal information, (3) the purposes for which the business uses that information, (4) the categories of third parties with whom the business discloses the information, and (5) the categories of information that the business sells or discloses to third parties. You can make a request to know up to twice a year, free of charge.
- **Delete** personal data we collected from you. Exercise your right delete.
- **Correct** inaccurate personal information that we maintain about you. Exercise your right to correct.
- Access the personal information that we hold about you, including specific pieces of personal information CSI has collected about you.
- Limit the use and disclosure of certain sensitive personal information to uses necessary to
  provide the products and services reasonably expected by the consumer requesting them.
  This right is limited to sensitive personal information collected or processed for the purpose
  of inferring characteristics about you. Exercise your right to limit the use of your sensitive
  information.
- **Opt-out of selling or sharing** your personal information including via a user-enabled global privacy control. <u>Exercise your right to opt-out.</u>
- Non-Discrimination and equal treatment if you choose to exercise any of your rights under the CCPA.

## Know, Delete or Correct Your Personal Information

# Verifying Requests

To help protect your privacy and maintain security, we will take steps to verify your identity and prove California residency before granting you access to your personal information or complying with your request. We require you to provide verifiable information by providing a government issued ID and/or utility bill: full name, street address, city/state, and zip/postal code.

In addition, if you do not wish to not share your personal information through means of government issued identification and you ask us to provide you with specific pieces of personal information, we will require you to sign a notarized declaration under penalty of perjury, that you are the consumer whose personal information is the subject of the request. If you designate an authorized agent to make an access or deletion request on your behalf (a) we may require you to provide the authorized agent notarized written permission to do so, and (b) for deletion requests, we may require you to verify your own identity directly with us (as described above).



## CCPA NOTICE AT COLLECTION

The CCPA requires businesses to give consumers certain information in a "notice at collection." A notice at collection must list the categories of personal information businesses collect about consumers and the purposes for which they use the categories of information. This section is intended to provide the *Notice at Collection* required under the CCPA.
